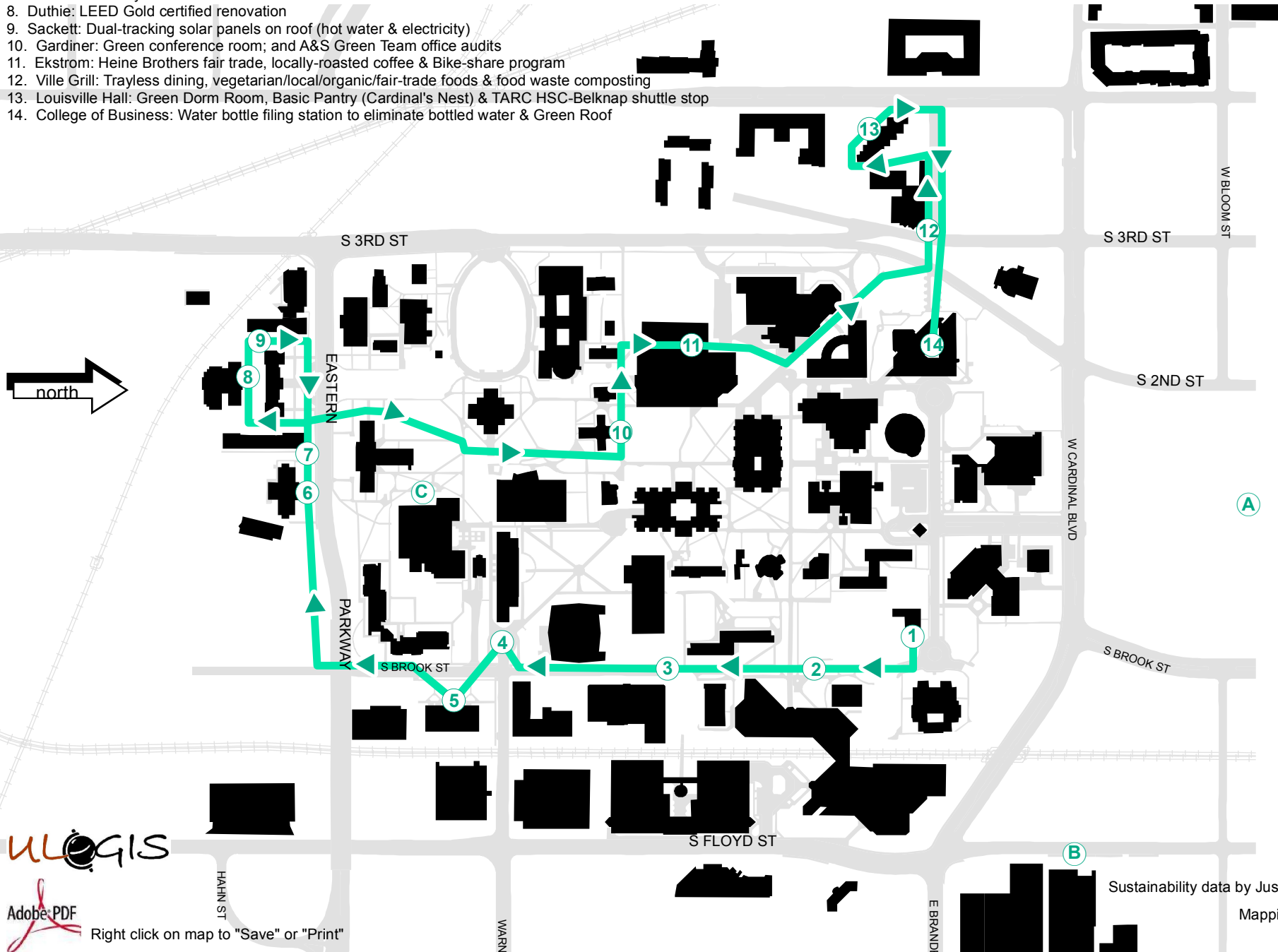


UNIVERSITY OF LOUISVILLE: BELKNAP CAMPUS SUSTAINABILITY

3. Threlkeld: Single-stream recycling & energy-efficiency retrofits
4. Lutz Circle: Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) pickups & No-Idling Policy
5. Steam & Chilled Water Plant: Coal-free campus
6. Ernst: Biodiesel program & Conn Center for Renewable Energy Research
7. Eastern Parkway: Road diet - bike lanes & bus shelters
8. Duthie: LEED Gold certified renovation
9. Sackett: Dual-tracking solar panels on roof (hot water & electricity)
10. Gardiner: Green conference room; and A&S Green Team office audits
11. Ekstrom: Heine Brothers fair trade, locally-roasted coffee & Bike-share program
12. Ville Grill: Trayless dining, vegetarian/local/organic/fair-trade foods & food waste composting
13. Louisville Hall: Green Dorm Room, Basic Pantry (Cardinal's Nest) & TARC HSC-Belknep shuttle stop
14. College of Business: Water bottle filling station to eliminate bottled water & Green Roof

- B. Surplus property for exchange/reuse and e-waste recycling
- C. MiTC experimentation micro-clover plot-lower maintenance and fixes nitrogen to maintain soil fertility
